



# WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

The Internet is an amazing tool. It has the power to change the way we live, and we're starting to see that potential today. With only a few mouse-clicks, you can follow the news, look up facts, buy goods and services, and communicate with others from around the world. It's important to Eseovhe Egborge PC doing business as PedPost Pediatric Urgent Care (PedPost Urgent Care) to help our patients and employees retain their privacy when they take advantage of all the Internet based software (website, patient and staff portal) has to offer.

We believe your business or information your share is no one else's. Your privacy is important to you and to us. So we'll protect the information you share with us. To protect your privacy, PedPost Urgent Care follows different principles in accordance with worldwide practices for customer privacy and data protection.

- We won't sell or give away your name, mail address, phone number, email address or any other information to anyone.
- We'll use state-of-the-art security measures to protect your information from unauthorized users.

## NOTICE

We will ask you when we need information that personally identifies you (personal information) or allows us to contact you. Generally, this information is requested when you register with us using our various web-based portals (website, intake kiosks, patient portal) or when you create a Registration ID on the site or when you download permissible or authorized software, or enter a contest, order email newsletters or join or subscribe to partner websites through our website.

## CONSENT

If you choose not to register or provide personal information, you can still use most of <https://www.pedpost.com/>. But you will not be able to access areas that require registration.

If you decide to register, you will be able to select the kinds of information you want to receive from us by subscribing to various services, like our electronic newsletters. If you do not want us to communicate with you about other offers regarding Eseovhe Egborge PC products, programs, events, or services by email, postal mail, or telephone, you may select the option stating that you do not wish to receive marketing messages from Eseovhe Egborge PC.

Eseovhe Egborge PC occasionally allows other companies to offer our registered customers information about their products and services, using postal mail only. If you do not want to receive these offers, you may select the option stating that you do not wish to receive marketing materials from third parties.

## **ACCESS**

We will provide you with the means to ensure that your personal information is correct and current. You may review and update this information at any time in your patient portal account or on our website. There, you can:

- View and edit personal information you have already given us.
- Tell us whether you want us to send you marketing information, or whether you want third parties to send you their offers by postal mail.
- Sign up for electronic newsletters about our services and products.
- Register. Once you register, you won't need to do it again. Wherever you go on the portal or <https://www.pedpost.com/>, your information stays with you.

## **SECURITY**

Eseovhe Egborge PC has taken strong measures to protect the security of your personal information and to ensure that your choices for its intended use are honored. We take strong precautions to protect your data from loss, misuse, unauthorized access or disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

We guarantee your e-commerce transactions to be 100% safe and secure. When you place orders or access your personal account information, you're utilizing secure server software SSL, which encrypts your personal information before it's sent over the Internet. SSL is one of the safest encryption technologies available.

In addition, your transactions are guaranteed under the Fair Credit Billing Act. This Act states that your bank cannot hold you liable for more than \$50.00 in fraudulent credit card charges. If your bank does hold you liable for \$50.00 or less, we'll cover your liability provided the unauthorized, fraudulent use of your credit card resulted through no fault of your own and from purchases made from us over our secure server. In the event of unauthorized use of your credit card, you must notify your credit card provider in accordance with its reporting rules and procedures.

Eseovhe Egborge PC strictly protects the security of your personal information and honors your choices for its intended use. We carefully protect your data from loss, misuse, unauthorized access or disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

Your personal information is never shared outside the company without your permission, except under conditions explained above. Inside the company, data is stored in password-controlled servers with limited access. Your information may be stored and processed in United States or any other country where Eseovhe Egborge PC, its subsidiaries, affiliates or agents are located.

You also have a significant role in protecting your information. No one can see or edit your personal information without knowing your user name and password, so do not share these with others.

## **PATIENT PROFILES**

As mentioned above, every registered patient who signs up with our Patient Portal has a unique personal profile. Each profile is assigned a unique personal identification number, which helps us ensure that only you can access your profile.

## **WHAT WE DO WITH THE INFORMATION YOU SHARE**

When you communicate with us via our website or your patient portal account, you provide us with your contact information and email address. We use this information to send you updates about your medical records, lab results, imaging results, questionnaires to measure your satisfaction with our service and announcements about new and exciting services that we offer. When you make payments to us, we ask for your credit card number and billing address. We use this information only to bill you for the services or product(s) you order at that time. For your convenience, we do save billing information in case you want to order from us again, but we don't use this information again without your permission.

We occasionally hire other companies to provide limited services on our behalf, including merchant services, packaging, mailing and delivering purchases, answering customer questions about products or services, sending postal mail and processing event registration. We will only provide those companies the information they need to deliver the service, and they are prohibited from using that information for any other purpose.

Esevhe Egborge PC will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Esevhe Egborge PC or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Esevhe Egborge PC and its family of Websites, and, (c) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Esevhe Egborge PC, its Websites, or the public.
